## MARILYN PEEL SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD NOMINATION

At the end of the season, members will vote to award one member the Marilyn Peel Sportsmanship award. Any PRWTA member is eligible to be nominated, to nominate someone, and to vote. Nominations will be accepted until September 15, and then each member will be asked to vote from the slate of nominees.

The following are characteristics that embody good sportsmanship for members of PRWTA. These criteria should be considered when nominating members for the award:

1. Flexible, prompt, and amicable in scheduling matches
2. Promotes, and cheerfully engages in, random mixing of play during Open Play
3. Positive attitude regarding opponents, partner, and self while playing
4. Consistent use of tennis etiquette
5. Knows and follows PRWTA rules
6. Helps promote and support PRWTA activities
7. Is a member in good standing (MIGS)
